Getting Started with Your Small Volume Nebulizer Assembly


- Wash your hands, and gather everything you will need:
 - a) Nebulizer circuit: includes medication cup, tubing, mouthpiece and T-piece **NOTE**: Some T-pieces are attached to the mouthpiece
 - b) Nebulizer compressor (the machine)
 - c) Medication
 - d) If you are to use a special mask to take your treatments, your Solace Medical Representative will instruct you on how to use the mask.
- Attach one end of the tubing, if required, to the compressor, and the other end to the nebulizer cup's stem
- Add the medication to the nebulizer cup, and attach the lid to the cup
- Attach T- piece and mouthpiece to the nebulizer
- You are now ready to begin treatment.

How to take Your Treatment

- If possible, it is best to sit in an upright position to take your treatments.
- If required, plug the compressor's power cord into a properly-grounded electrical outlet.
- Turn the power switch to the **ON** position.
- Place your lips tightly around the nebulizer's mouthpiece.
- Breathe in slowly and deeply through your mouth only.
- Then, breathe out slowy through the nebulizer mouthpiece.
 You do not have to remove the mouthpiece from your mouth to exhale
- Every few breaths, take in a slow, deep breath, and **HOLD** it for few seconds before exhaling. This will allow the medication to settle in your lungs.
- Continue the treatment until the medication is gone (usually about 10 minutes), or unless otherwise instructed.
- If you feel dizzy or shaky, or you feel your heart racing, stop the treatment for a
 few minutes and rest. Usually these feelings will go away within a few minutes
 so you can finish your treatment. If they continue, contact your physician NOTE: You
 may need to cough during and after the treatment to remove any loosened secretion
- When finished with your treatment, turn your unit OFF.
- Take nebulizer cup to the sink for cleaning (under Cleaning/Replacement Schedule)









Cleaning/Replacement Schedule

FREQUENCY	SUPPLIES	WHAI IU DU	
After each treatment	Mouthpiece or mask T-piece Mediction cup	Take apart the nebulizer set, and rince the mouthpiece, T-piece and medication cup with clear water. Let the pieces dry between two clean paper towels until the next treatment. DO NOT try to clean the tubing.	
Every day	Mouthpiece or mask T-piece Medication	Wash the mouthpice, T-piece and and medication cup with warm soapy water, and inse well. Soak the pieces for the 30 minutes in a solution of 1 part white vinegar and 3 parts water. Rinse the pieces very well in warm, clean, clear water. Let the pieces dry between two clean paper towels until the the next treatment	
Every week	Compressor	Make sure compressor is unplugged, and wipe outside of compressor with a damp cloth.	
Every two weeks	Nebulizer circuit	Nebulizer circuit Replace your nebulizer circuit with a new one.	
At least monthly	Air inlet filter Check the air inlet filter. Clean or change the filter as instructed by your representative. Obtain filters from local branch office.		
NOTE: Any other maintenance	should be completed by authorized s	srvice center.	

IMPORTANT SAFETY REMINDERS

- DO NOT change treatment dosage without asking your doctor. Please noify Solace Medical of any changes.
 If you you feel dizzy or shaky, or you feel your heart racing during your treatment, stop and reast. If these feelings continue, call your doctor.
 DO NOT allow the vents on the compressor to be blocked by papers, tablecloths, curtains, etc Keep area clear.
- 4. It is better not to useextension cords. If necessary, use only heavy-duty extension cords.
 5. DO NOT operate multiple devices from a single outlet.
- 6. Unplug the compressor before cleaning

Troubleshooting Guide			
PROBLEM	POSSIBLE CAUSE	WHAT TO DO	
Compressor will not operate	Power cord not plugged in	Plug unit into eletrical outlet.	
	No power to outlet	Change to different outlet	
	Power switch not in the ON position	Turn switch to ON position.	
	Equipment malfunction	Call us.	
Machine is operating, but little or no mist is being created	Tubing kinked or loosely connected	Straighten tubing. Tighten cnnection.	
	Nebulizer not held in upright position	Place nebulizer in upright position.	
	Filter needs to be replaced or cleaned	Clean and/or replace filter.	
	Nebulizer is clogged or broken	Replace nebulizer cup.
